Professional Lumberjack Contest

Alden Field, Cherry Valley, NY



Competition format: An open field of men will compete in 5 events with final placings determined by event finals; the top 15 competitors registered in each event will be automatically seeded into 5 semifinal heats of 5. Preliminaries will determine the remaining 10 positions for the semi-final round in each event. Qualifying will be based on times; semifinal heats will be seeded and the winner of each heat will advance to the event final. Video judging will be used to time qualifying heats and to verify seminal heat winners. Axe throwing is open to both men and women, qualifications will be used to form an 8 person elimination bracket. Jack and Jill sawing will be conducted as heats (Saturday) with a final of 5 teams held on Sunday. This competition will be held in conjunction with the STIHL Timbersports Men’s Northeast Qualifier and STIHL Timbersports Women’s Division. The general layout of events for the weekend is below.

Friday June 15th

- 9am-4pm: STIHL Timbersports Women’s Division Time trials (top 16 advance)
- 9am-4pm: Men’s Event Preliminaries for unseeded men (top 10 per event advance to semifinals)
- 6pm-8:30 STIHL Men’s Northeastern Qualifier

Saturday June 16th

- 9am-1: Semis of open events and Heats of Jack and Jill
- 2-5pm: STIHL Women’s semifinals (2 pools of 8)

Sunday June 17th

- 10am-2pm Remaining Semifinals for men’s open events and Women’s Endurance
- 3pm- 5pm Finals for Open events and Women’s Endurance
